ECZEMA: HOMEOPATHIC APPROACH

Eczema is a chronic inflammatory, non-contagious condition of the skin which is characterized by a red itchy, bumpy rash. The skin is dry and flaky and can also lead to thickening and hardening (lichenification) at the later stages. It is often synonymously used with the term 'dermatitis' and 'atopic dermatitis'. Eczema may be either acute or chronic. It may occur abruptly or gradually and may last for a few weeks or months or years.

Causes:

- Genetic tendencies, Eczema often runs in families.
- Some seasonal allergies like pollen allergies and hay fever are at their peak from March to May.

- Prolonged stress can be a triggering factor for some individuals at some stage in their life.

Symptoms:

- Dry, itchy, and flaky skin.
- Lesions appear at the folds of the skin in 50%- 60% of individuals. Areas around the neck, in folds of the elbow, folds of the buttocks, and behind the knees are involved. But, they can also appear in singular dry hyperpigmented patches in other areas, such as the face, upper back, buttocks (as in nappy rash in infants), etc.
- Pus-like eruptions (as in nummular eczema, seborrhoeic dermatitis, stasis dermatitis) are seen that ooze white or yellow discharge. They can also be accompanied by a foul smell if the superadded bacterial infection exists.
- Hyperpigmentation and lichenification (hardening) of the skin occurs in the affected areas in the later stages.

Homeopathy for Eczema:

- Homeopathy has a good scope in treating recently detected cases of mild and moderate eczema. These cases usually require eight to twelve months of treatment.
